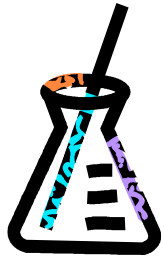

A.M. Cooking with the Playful Chef, Alisa Tammaro:

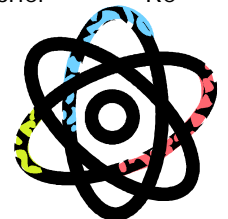
Monday through Friday

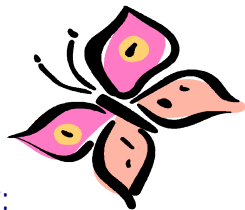
Tuesday:

EXTENDED DAYCARE

Additional supervision before and after the camp:

Morning extended care: 7:30 A.M. to 8:30 A.M.

Evening extended care: 3:30 P.M. to 4:30 P.M.

Cost: \$4.50 per hour

- Parents must notify Camp Director of Intent to use Extended Care.
- Families will be billed for Extended Care at the end of each week.
- Snacks and drinks will be provided.
- Daily schedule of activities planned.
- Bring sunscreen, towel, and swimsuit daily for water games.

Any waivers and/or forms for destinations along with the Diocesan permission slips must be completed prior to camp. Failure to complete required paperwork will prevent your child(ren) from participating in camp and boarding the bus for activities.

***SSPP School is not responsible for any lost or stolen items. Please be sure children take their belongings home daily.



For Your Information

- A daily sign-in/sign –out process will be enforced. Parents and care givers must come into the school hall for drop-off and pick-up of their child(ren).
- Please be sure any necessary waivers or forms are completed before the start of the camp day.
- Weekly agendas will be distributed on the Monday of each week with any updates and reminders.
- A.M. and P.M. snacks and drinks are included daily.
- Please have your child bring a backpack or tote bag daily, containing a change of clothes, swimsuit, towel and sun-screen. Please have ALL items labeled with child's first and last name.
- All children are expected to follow safety rules on the buses and through camp.
- Camp registration is on a first come, first serve basis. Class size is limited on various days.
- Volunteer Chaperones are needed on some field trips. If you are interested, please let us know. Any admission prices will be waived for Chaperones ~ availability limited.
